Research in varied forms and varied fields were introduced by faculty and staff researchers of Lorma Colleges. The researches were on the fields of Information Technology, Nursing, Pharmacy, Education and Culture that were qualified in renowned national and international conferences.

The first presented was "Multi Exit Configuration of Mesoscopic Pedestrian Simulation" by Mr. Allan R. Lao, CCSE faculty. Mr. Christian T. Montemayor, CAS Faculty and Research Coordinator then presented his study on "The Roles of Lalakayen in Local Conflicts Settlement."

Meanwhile, the study "Fourth Year Student Nurses' Compliance to Universal Precautions," was discussed by Lenie A. Buccat, CON Faculty and Research Coordinator. Also by another CON faculty was the research entitled "Antibacterial of Sineguelas Bark Against Streptococcus Pyogens."

Claiming that they applied learning theories in their research, Grace G. Nabanalan, CAS Faculty presented "The Dyadic Method of Teaching Trigonometry".

Qualified to the National Climate Change Conference was "Disaster Preparedness: looking through the Lens of Selected Hospitals in San Fernando City, La Union" presented by Melquaiades Ancheta, CON Faculty.
